OUTREACH & RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES

****Parent Outreach Assistant**

Assist parenting instructor in making weekly phone calls and preparing materials for weekly classes. Days and Hours are flexible.

Breakfast and Lunch for the Homeless

Help prepare and serve food for impoverished persons in our community. Mealtimes: Mon & Wed. 8:30-10:30am (serve 9-11:30) and Tues. & Thurs. 8:30-1pm (serve 11-2pm). Location: Molten Hall.

Assistant Coach

Help coach one practice and one game weekly within a 3 month seasonal session for sports leagues including – soccer, basketball, volleyball, & flag football. Must have knowledge of the sport. At least 6 month commitment in volunteering at the center in general is desired.

Recreational Assistant

Help in creating recreational games in the youth center and in the gym at least once per week, as well as engaging and supervising kids.

Young Life/ Wyldlife

Be a guest speaker or assist staff and our student leaders every other Friday for games, food, songs, a message. Camps in the summer and winter. Tentatively 6pm-7:30pm.

Coaches Clinic

Develop a 2 day sports training for youth that will help develop athletic skills for volleyball, basketball, soccer, flag football, street hockey, or other. Must have knowledge of the sport.

LITERACY & ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Learning Center Tutor (Spanish speakers a plus)

This position supports the activities of the Learning Center at Bresee. This position involves helping students with homework. Usual work hours are Monday through Friday between 3:30PM until 6:30PM, with busiest hours from 4:15-5:15.

Tutor young adults in the Career Counseling Department

In our Workforce Investment Act (WIA) internship program, this position involves tutoring students (18-24 years) in Math, doing mock interviews, assisting in résumé writing and career planning. Schedule varies.

Speak to our young people and inspire them to think about their future and the importance of their education, going to college etc... Monday-Thursday, 5:30-6:30 pm.

SAT Preparation Instructor

Conduct or assist with workshops covering SAT skills and strategies. Assist with practice test.

College Enrollment Assistant

Help students with college applications and essays, or financial aid enrollment. Hours vary.

****HOSTS Mentor**

The HOSTS (Help One Student To Succeed) Program provides successful one-to-one mentoring.

- ❖ A mentor works with an individual student on materials and activities prepared by the HOSTS instructor to target specific skills. Mentors do not necessarily need to be English or Math experts, as lesson plans are provided, the level of instruction is often basic.
- ❖ One hour per week with a 6 month minimum commitment.
- ❖ Schedules arranged for your needs
